****Notes for Item 10**

Bleached: refers to fabric which is bleached, dyed white or treated with a white dressing.

Dyed: refers to fabric which is dyed a single uniform color other than white, or treated with a colored finish other than white or consisting of a colored yarn of a single uniform color

Yarns of different colors: refers to fabric consisting of yarns of different shades of the same color (other than the natural color of the constituent fibers) and fabric consisting of both bleached or unbleached yarn and colored yarn.

Printed: refers to fabric which has been printed in the piece, whether or not made from yarns of different colors.
